In partnership with Sexual Health and QAHC, FPQ's Townsville staff hit the university and TAFE orientation days this year to ensure students were aware how to have sex safely.

The *Safe Sex. No regrets* campaign promotes the message that part of getting ready for a night out is being prepared for safe sex. Condoms are the most effective way of preventing STIs and unwanted pregnancy, however, research by Latrobe University found only 44% of men and 35% of women always use condoms with casual partners.

The stalls were very popular, with an overwhelming response to surveys testing sexual knowledge. Many students also took the opportunity to stock up on free condoms, lollies and information.

The information collected will be analysed to gauge the effectiveness of the *Safe sex. No regrets.* campaign in the North, and to plan future education programs
