Participants attend a three day face to face theory course focused on contraception, unplanned pregnancy and STIs. The following topics are covered in the course:

- Facilitating contraceptive choice
- Barrier methods and natural methods of family planning
- Hormonal contraception
- IUDs and sterilisation
- Unplanned pregnancy issues
- STIs
- Blood borne viruses
- Issues in sexual health service delivery
- Preparation for clinical practice
- Assessments

Following the three-day theory course, participants have six months to complete and submit the theory assessment workbook
