

Contraception module for DRANZCOG candidates

This module has been specifically designed for doctors undertaking training for the DRANZCOG

All methods of contraception will be covered in a full day theory workshop where the emphasis will be on practical aspects and case based discussions. Prior to the workshop-all participants will be expected to have completed pre reading.

Participants can then arrange 3 half day practical sessions working with experienced staff at an FPQ clinic.
