Participants who complete the course will be eligible to apply to become an authorised non-medical Pap smear provider and to access data on the Queensland Health Pap Smear Register.

> Pap smear provider module

The **Pap smear provider module** is for registered nurses, enrolled nurses and aboriginal health workers who work in settings that provide cervical screening services, including general practice settings and rural and remote areas.

> Eligibility and prerequisites

- Registered nurses who work in a setting where they may provide cervical screening services (including general practice and rural and remote areas).
- Current AHPRA registration.
- This course is also open to enrolled nurses and health workers where appropriate workplace support is available to them.
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health workers must have completed a Certificate IV in Primary Health Care or equivalent.
- FPQ's *Introduction to sexual and reproductive health theory* or equivalent is an advantage.

> Course objective

To provide an opportunity to develop cervical screening practice skills.

> Course content

- Theory component

Participants attend a three day face to face theory course and submit a completed theory workbook (within six months of theory component)

- Clinical attachment component

The clinical attachment is to be completed within twelve weeks of the theory course and can be undertaken in FPQ clinics in Brisbane, Ipswich, Toowoomba, Townsville, Cairns and Rockhampton. A minimum of 2-3 days clinical supervision is required with a minimum of 15 Pap smears performed.

- Assessments

The assessment requirements are completion of theory workbook, completion of clinical portfolio, demonstration of additional readings and case study.
